The prerequisite is that you have a residence title as specified in Section 8 of the BAföG Act.            If you do not meet the requirements of § 8 of the BAföG, you can still apply to one of the party-affiliated foundations. The <i>Reemtsma-Begabtenförderungswerk</i> supports low income students. A scholarship can be received until the completion of the 9. university semester and / or the 30th birthday. The <i>Dr. Arthur Pfungst Stiftung</i> supports students with good grades and financial need. German as well as <b>international students</b> can receive a scholarship. If you are pursuing a first degree (Bachelor's, Master's, state examination) full-time at a state university, you can apply. Second degrees as well as studies abroad are generally not supported. Students with non-German citizenship can be funded if they are studying in the federal territory. Funding from the 3rd university semester at the earliest. According to the website, the foundation has fixed requirements regarding the grade point average (2.0 or 2.5).
